Know your basic legal employment rights:

- A minimum wage - see www.gov.uk/national-minimum-wage-rates
- 28 days holiday if you are full-time or a percentage if you are part-time
- Time off for study if you are 16 or 17 years old
- Paid time off for women during, and after, pregnancy
- Paid paternity, and adoption, leave
- A maximum 48-hour week and breaks in the working day
- Not to be unfairly dismissed and entitled to redundancy pay (after two years' work)
